

Psychology Graduates – Work Opportunities - Supporting Private Practice

Opportunity for psychology graduates to work part-time in private practice

Whether you have an undergraduate degree in psychology, including a fourth year, or are now a provisional psychologist on any of the various pathways to full registration, there are now work opportunities in our practice.

- A. Entry level positions include general clinical and practice support to the principal psychologist.
- B. Further, there are opportunities to progress to work as a behaviour support practitioner in the NDIS system.

Of course, if you chose to stay with us if you achieve full registration as a psychologist, many other work opportunities would open up including usual mental health counselling via various referral channels including Medicare, DVA, Workcover, EAP etc, group work, and more.

Work hours and start dates

During an initial probationary period (likely to be 3 months), 0.2 to 0.4 EFT, by negotiation. Potential for such hours to extend via mutual agreement after the successful completion of the probationary period.

Immediate opportunities on the Sunshine Coast, Queensland.

Similar opportunities in the south-eastern suburbs of Melbourne from February – March 2023.

Work location(s)

A work from home opportunity with regular videoconference supervision and mentoring, with some office-based and face-to-face activity as required.

Travel will be required some weeks, with financial allowances applicable.

Immediate opportunities on the Sunshine Coast, Queensland. Based around the Maroochydore – Mooloolaba – Nambour region.

South-eastern Melbourne. From the CBD then to the south and into south-eastern suburbs.

Work requirements

- a. Must be an Australian citizen or have permanent residency status in Australia.
- b. Consent to undertake a police check will be requested.
- c. Hold an active licence to drive a motor vehicle in Australia.
- d. Access to a reliable motor vehicle given these roles will require regular travel in the vicinity of your usual home location.
- e. Will be required to attain a Working with Children clearance (blue card in Queensland).
- f. Will be required to attain a yellow card for the NDIS system.
- g. Must have capacity to work honestly, diligently and autonomously with minimal daily supervision.
- h. Motivated by successful completion of outcomes. Thus, a 'results' driven person with an 'attention to detail' work ethic.
- i. Possess an open-mindedness, a desire to learn always and commitment to diversity, legal and ethical behaviour and superior customer service.

Work provisions

A company-owned laptop will be provided to all successful candidates, including Windows-based operating system with Office-365 software and appropriate cyber security, etc.

Mobile phone access will be negotiated or provided.

Other infrastructure will be provided and negotiated in due course, as identified as necessary.

Remuneration

Standard award rates plus minimum of 10% loading will be negotiated for all successful candidates.

Employment as an employee with all statutory entitlements including holiday leave and loading, sick leave entitlements, other family leave entitlements, superannuation, etc.

Travel allowance will be paid as applicable.
